The City of Clemson will hold a public hearing concerning program performance and accomplishments conducted under a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project known as CDBG # 4-CE-23-001, **Clemson Able/Curtis Sidewalk Improvements**, wherein the following activities:

Mobilization, demolition, clearing & grubbing, backfill, grading, & stabilization, erosions control, tree protection, tree removal, 18" curb & gutter, 2,800 LF of 5' sidewalks, pedestrian ramps, ADA handrail and curb ramp, catch basin, junction box, stormwater tie in, pavement marking, signage, PVC water line, gate valves, new meter boxes, and asphalt paving.
