Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Madame Chair Lisa Robinson @ 6:00pm.

Roll Call: Roll was called by Madame Chair Lisa Robinson. All active members in attendance.

Approval of Agenda: Kevin Dull made a motion to approve. Pablo Unda Seconded. Motion carried.

Approval of previous meeting minutes – April 23, 2026: Kevin Dull made a motion to approve. Elaine Masceri seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Citizen Comments: Kazi Rana, outgoing president of Graduate Clemson Student government, in audience observing meeting. He has applied to serve on the board.

Department Status / Staffing Review: Chief Campos provided a synopsis of current matters with the *Department*.

- One vacancy for officer
- Two new hires that completed pre-academy and will be starting SCCJA on June 7.
- One officer in field training
- Two new jail hires have started and are going through training
- Even though students are gone we stay busy
- Have a “trauma-informed interviews” class starting at the department next week for us and other agencies.
- Chief Campos attended the ITGA conference in College Station, TX along with several members of City Hall and CU. The school has over 81,000 students.
 - Same conference will be at Chapel Hill next year
- Chief Campos would like to entertain making one of the board positions into something more related to Clemson University. Possibly someone from the President’s office or Dean of Students, etc. Add it to the agenda for next time. (Pablo Unda mentioned office of community relations)
- There is a bill going through the state house and senate that says division one collegiate events allow golf carts to be used as long as law enforcement directs traffic. It has been attached to another bill. It has not been signed by the governor yet. We have requested that he remove that part of the bill. The area covered was shown to board members. Statute would affect Clemson, USC and Conway.
