

CLEMSON POLICE ADVISORY BOARD MINUTES

Date: Thursday, July 23, 2026

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Madam Chair Lisa Robinson @ 6:00pm.

Roll Call: Roll was called by Madam Chair Lisa Robinson

Approval of Agenda: Motion made by Kevin Dull. Seconded by Paul Schleifer. Motion passed.

Approval of previous meeting minutes – June 26, 2026: Elaine Masceri made a motion to approve. Kevin Dull seconded. Motion carried.

Citizen Comments: No citizen's comments or questions presented.

Dr. Pettigrew Presentation – Started in this role about 3months ago and is a Clemson Alumni. The purpose of the office is to investigate reported violations of student regulations, arrange for cases to be adjudicated and maintain confidential records. He expects to hold students to standards but allow them to make mistakes by giving them resources to correct those mistakes and learn from them. This department also adjudicates cases for student groups. They handle outreach, education, student support and referrals. All allegations are investigated on a case-by-case basis. Dr. Pettigrew works closely with multiple departments and organizations to give students all available opportunities and keep the community as safe as possible.

Department Status / Staffing Review: Chief Campos provided a synopsis of current matters with the Department.

- Two dispatch vacancies – interviews coming up
- 3 officer vacancies
 - One is for our SRO that is leaving us. Will be filled internally

Crime Review: Chief Campos gave a rundown of the crime stats for June.

- 11 DUI
- 45 incarcerations
- 1 MIP
- 50 motor vehicle accidents
 - 10 with injuries
- 13 simple assaults
- 8 thefts from motor vehicles
- 6 narcotics violations
- 12 disorderly conducts
- 13 liquor law violations

In ref to the recent press release, the Chine Express case is still active and we cannot divulge more details at this time. There is a lot of evidence to be sifted through.

Discuss City Ordinance 18-27: Chief Campos spoke with a local Uber driver and they seem to be in favor of eliminating the ordinance. It no longer seems to be relevant with current climate and accessibility.

The locations listed for cameras, etc. are no longer valid. It also wasn't easily enforceable. Paul Schleifer made a motion to recommend removing ordinance 18-27 to Clemson City Council. Elaine Masceri seconded. Vote passed unanimously to recommend to city council the removal of ordinance 18-27.

Requested Presentations: Madame Chair Lisa Robinson suggested having the student government president present in September. Sandy Edge suggested having Highway Patrol or someone like present on event traffic.

Board Member Open Discussion: Camryn MacAlarney has created a Google form for students to ask questions or present concerns. Chief Campos reminded everyone that anything presented becomes public record.

Adjournment: Motion made by Pablo Unda to adjourn. Motion seconded by (unknown) Motion Carried.
