

CLEMSON POLICE ADVISORY BOARD MINUTES

Date: Thursday, April 23, 2026

Members in Attendance: Lisa Robinson, Winton Hunter, Kevin Dull, Elaine Masceri, Ava Ross, Caroline Beatty and Chief Campos.

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Madame Chair Lisa Robinson @ 6:00pm.

Roll Call: Roll was called by Madame Chair Lisa Robinson. Paul Schleifer and Pablo Unda are absent.

Approval of Agenda: **Madame Chair Lisa Robinson made motion to add Mayor Halfacre to speak moving #9 up to #3.** Madame Chair Lisa Robinson made motion to approve agenda. Seconded by Winton Hunter. Motion carried with the amendment.

Presentation of Certificates to Caroline Beatty and Ava Ross - Mayor Halfacre spoke to the board to thank them for their time and service. Chief Campos presented appreciation certificates to Caroline Beatty and Ava Ross.

Approval of previous meeting minutes – March 26, 2026: Sandy Edge made a motion to approve. Winton Hunter seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Citizen Comments: No citizen's comments or questions presented.

Presentation by Ethan Barnette (Storm Water Division Manager) – The police department works closely with this department during inclement weather. Visual presentation attached to meeting. Always looking to reduce impact from storm water. Ethan works with other municipalities to educate the public and encourage public involvement and participation. They inspect lakes and creeks and other discharge points. Monitor construction sites and focus on Pollution Prevention and good housekeeping. City has about 1400 catch basins and about 19miles of pipe. Madame Chair Lisa Robinson asked what to do if they saw blocked catch basins. Ethan advised to call Utilities main line or go on to the MyCivic app to put in a storm water work order.

Department Status / Staffing Review: Chief Campos provided a synopsis of current matters with the *Department*.

- Two dispatch/jailers graduated jail academy and are back at work
- Two vacancies in dispatch
 - One offer of employment made
 - One in background
- Full on officers right now
 - 3 in field training
 - One is about to graduate field training
- CPD charity Golf tournament is May 5th at Boscobel
- City extended sidewalks Martin St and Riggs neighborhoods, they are using a bollard system wide enough for golf carts, scooters and or motorcycles to get through.
- We are almost finished with the jail renovations
- CPD received an Agency of the Year Award for DUI enforcement for 2025

Crime Review: Chief Campos gave a rundown of the crime stats for March.

- 716 traffic stops
- 223 citations

- 40 prisoners
- 2 MIP
- 75 accidents
 - 6 with injuries
- 1 robbery
- 1 aggravated assault
- 2 breaking and entering
- 1 breaking into a vehicle
- 7 narcotics violations
- 18 disorderly conducts

We are preparing for the concerts and graduations. The concert will be handled similar to a game.

Sandy Edge asked about traffic. Chief Campos explained this time of year traffic patterns vary due to what events we have going on.
