

CLEMSON POLICE ADVISORY BOARD MINUTES

Date: Thursday, March 26, 2026

Members in Attendance: Lisa Robinson, Winton Hunter, Kevin Dull, Elaine Masceri, Pablo Unda, Ava Ross, Paul Schleifer and Chief Campos.

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Madame Chair Lisa Robinson @ 6:00pm.

Roll Call: Roll was called by Madame Chair Lisa Robinson. Members Sandy Edge and Caroline Beatty have excused absences.

Approval of Agenda: Kevin Dull made motion to approve agenda. Seconded by Elaine Masceri. Motion carried.

Approval of previous meeting minutes – February 26, 2026: Pablo Unda made a motion to approve. Winton Hunter seconded. Motion carried.

Citizen Comments: No citizen's comments or questions presented.

Presentation by City Engineer Nathan Hinkle – Presentation on the Urban SDK process. Traffic calming - physical measures that reduce the negative effects of motor vehicle use, alter driver behavior and improve conditions for non-motorized street users. SDK is real time data. Complete presentation uploaded on PD and city website linked with this meeting.

Downtown streetscape project - increase pedestrian safety, make things more ADA accessible, reduce traffic, increase canopy coverage, remove the pavers and make things safer. The complete plan is posted on the City of Clemson Website. Lisa Robinson asked about trucks making deliveries for the downtown businesses. Chief Campos and Parking services are going to develop a new process for deliveries to assist downtown businesses. Elaine Masceri asked how Sloan St. would be accessed now. Nathan Hinkle advised it will be accessible from Keith St.

Audience member and resident Nanda Edgerton presented questions for Mr. Hinkle. Asking about reports that Adison Ln. will be turned into a pedestrian plaza and will Charleston Sports Pub no longer have access. Nathan advised that Charleston Sports pub has back gate access. She also asked about downtown delivers and Nathan advised they do not have an answer yet on deliveries. Ms. Edgerton asked if there would be a dedicated bicycle lane and if cyclists would be allowed to use the sidewalks if not. There will not be a dedicated lane but the traffic would be slow enough to allow bikes to safely share the roadway. Nathan and Chief Campos advised those are already dismount zones and would be illegal for them to ride on the sidewalks.

Department Status / Staffing Review: Chief Campos provided a synopsis of current matters with the *Department*.

- 2 officer vacancies but two starting in April
- 3 officers in field training
- 2 dispatch / jailer vacancies - have candidates in background
- 2 dispatch / jailers headed to the academy on Sunday
- We are now state accredited. (SCLEA)
- Our charity golf tournament is May 5th. We are still looking for participants, sponsors, and raffle prizes. This supports our community fund.

Crime Review: Chief Campos gave a rundown of the crime stats.

- 1 aggravated assault

- 10 simple assaults
- 3 motor vehicle thefts
- 5 DUI
- 16 disorderly conducts
- 32 MIP
- 2 contributing to delinquency of a minor
- 723 traffic stops
- 887 citations
- 3700 calls for service
- 35 in jail
- 59 vehicle collisions
 - 2 with injuries
- 80 parking citations issued by just our officers. Most are outside of downtown or overnight violations. (Does not include parking services citations issued)
- One of our most prolific vehicle burglars was released and went back to his habit. We re-arrested him and he was released again.
- We had a shooting on Pendleton Rd. @ Maple Blvd. 4 people in a car argued. 3 of them were juveniles. 1 jumped out of the vehicle and the others shot at him, then came back and shot again. Thankfully no people were struck. The subjects were all arrested that night. Witnesses were able to give general descriptions. License plate reader helped track down the vehicle.
- The Clemson Spring game is this Saturday.

Requested Presentations: Elaine Masceri requested Nathan Woods on the history of the planning and Ethan Barnette in storm water. Chief Campos advised they will request us to refer to the presentation Nathan has already given. Elaine Masceri asked about water issues and would like Ethan to do a presentation on deciding how to divert water. Chief Campos advised he would ask.
