

CLEMSON POLICE ADVISORY BOARD MINUTES

Date: Thursday, November 14, 2024

Members in Attendance: Madame Chair Lisa Robinson, Chief Campos, Winton Hunter, Steven Plant, Elaine Masceri, Sandy Edge, Kevin Dull, and Pablo Unda

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Madame Chair Lisa Robinson @ 6:00pm.

Roll Call: Roll was called by Madame Chair Lisa Robinson. Saniya Burns has an excused absence.

Approval of Agenda: Kevin Dull made motion to approve, Seconded by Sandy Edge. Motion carried.

Approval of previous meeting minutes – October 24, 2024: Correction: Madame Chair Lisa Robinson was not listed in attendance. Motion made to approve with the correction, seconded. Motion passed.

Citizen Comments: No citizen's comments or questions presented.

Presentation to Riley Wright and Ashby Williams: (Ashby Williams was not in attendance) Chief Campos presented to Riley Wright in thanks for his service on the PAB.

Department Status / Staffing Review: Chief Campos provided a synopsis of current matters with the Department.

- On Monday Chief spoke with the student senate to solicit student participation and communication. Introduced them to the crime map.
 - They asked a lot of questions about the alleged drink spiking but there has not been any substance identified and most have had extremely high BAC. May have also been interactions with alcohol and prescribed medications. Have spoken with the ER doctors and they are on board with helping determine if any foreign substances are present.
 - THERE HAVE BEEN NO DEATHS FROM A SPIKED DRINK IN TOWN
- 11 motor vehicle thefts - most were mopeds - two arrests made.
- The Dept. of Behavioral Health did a presentation last time and they have agreed to work with businesses downtown to have Narcan kits on hand in case there is an incident.
- 4 officer vacancies
 - received a resignation today for one
 - 4 candidates in the process of hiring - none certified
- 1 dispatch position open
 - none of our interviewees showed up for their interview so we are starting over

Crime Review: Chief Campos gave a rundown of the crime statistics for October 2024.

- 1 rape reported
- 1 aggravated assault
- 14 simple assault
- 1 break ins
- 3 break in to vehicles
- 11 vehicle thefts – most were mopeds or scooters
- 14 narcotics arrests
- 9 disorderly conduct
- 26 public drunk
- 12 minor in possession
- 3 DUI
- 6385 calls for service
- 893 traffic stops
- 402 citations
- 8 noise violations issued

- 61 vehicle collisions
 - o 7 had injuries

Madam Chair [Lisa Robinson](#) asked if the narcotics arrests were in a certain area. Chief Campos advised they are random

Requested Presentations: Previous requests reviewed. No new presentations submitted.

Board Member Open Discussion: Pablo Unda asked if the city receive any complaints of the racist texts sent to minority students. Chief Campos advised we did not, CUPD received several and let us know about it. We had calls from several people that do not live here and directed them to call their local PD. The FBI is investigating the texts nationwide. Madame Chair asked if this an instance where we would work with other agencies. Chief Campos said that when we first heard about it he reached out to the FBI to make sure they were aware. Dept. of Justice notified the FBI of multiple incidents across multiple states. Kevin Dull asked if there has been any crime uptick as a result of the hurricane. Chief Campos said no. Elaine Masceri asked about the digital speed limits and if there is any way to turn them around to address other people. Chief Campos advised public works is in charge of those. Council purchased several more of those signs and they have a directive to put them up but they are still cleaning up hurricane damage.

Adjournment: Elaine Masceri made a motion to adjourn. Winton Hunter 2nd. Motion passed.
