CLEMSON POLICE ADVISORY BOARD MINUTES

Date: Thursday, May 22, 2025

Members in Attendance: Madame Chair Lisa Robinson, Winton Hunter, Sandy Edge, Kevin Dull, Jacquie Myers, Pablo Unda, and Chief Campos.

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Madame Chair Lisa Robinson @ 6:00pm.

Roll Call: Roll was called by Madame Chair Lisa Robinson. Elaine Masceri has an excused absence. New High School and CU student members are Ava Ross and Carolyn Beatty. They will attend once school year begins.

Approval of Agenda: Jacquie Myers made motion to approve agenda. Seconded by Sandy Edge. Motion carried.

Approval of previous meeting minutes – April 24, 2025: Kevin Dull made a motion to approve. Pablo Unda seconded. Motion passed.

Citizen Comments: No citizens in the audience. No citizen's comments or questions presented.

Department Status / Staffing Review: Chief Campos provided a synopsis of current matters with the Department.

- 3 officers in field training
 - Two are certified and should be finished with field training soon
 - One non-certified employee should be going back to academy soon
- We have two officer vacancies we are trying to fill.
- We have two dispatch vacancies
 - Two dispatchers are out for medical reasons
- We went live with our new CAD system last week. So far so good.

Crime Review: Chief Campos gave a rundown of the crime statistics for April 2025.

- Crime map is not working. We are coordinating with the vendor to fix the issue
 - They have to change how they get the info due to the new system
- 4377 calls for service
- 466 traffic stops
- 247 citations
- 4 DUI
- 39 prisoners housed
- 23 noise complaints
 - 2 noise violations
- Over 60 vehicle collisions
 - 4 of those with injuries
- 11 assaults
 - two were aggravated assault
 - most were intimidation
- 7 motor vehicle thefts
 - most scooters or mopeds
 - 4 narcotics arrests
- 1 burglary reported
- Update we received the grant for the narcotics detective. We anticipate one of the cases they are working on should come to fruition and should see several narcotics arrests.
 - Jacquie Myers asked for some details on the grant details and what it funds.
 - Chief Campos advised it covered salary, computers, equipment, etc. Grant is for one year. We have applied to have it funded for an additional year.

- The Savannah Bananas game went almost as expected. The biggest hiccup was traffic getting out since everyone left at the same time.
- Lisa Robinson asked about the accident that occurred on SC93 / US76 that was on the news.
 - It's still being investigated by CUPD since it occurred in their jurisdiction.
- Chief Campos discussed an ordinance we are considering presenting in reference to the parking deck. It is an effort to curb youth using the parking deck as a hangout. We do not currently have an ordinance to address it. It is a public space, but there are cities in SC that have. The city attorney is helping research those ordinances to find something that suits our circumstances. Chief Campos asks to put this as an agenda item for the next meeting once the city attorney has a chance to review.
 - Pablo Unda asked if there was any physical damage that was a result of these things
 - Chief Campos mentioned the incident in ref to a juvenile that damaged an elevator in the parking deck.

Requested Presentations: The active shooter presentation request is still on the table. Chief Campos advised he will get it scheduled. Also need to discuss moving the August meeting at the next meeting.

Board Member Open Discussion: The LSU game was mentioned. Chief Campos advised we will be prepped for it.

Adjournment: Jacque Myers made a motion to adjourn. Motion was seconded by Kevin Dull and carried.
