CLEMSON POLICE ADVISORY BOARD MINUTES

Date: Thursday, October 23, 2025

Members in Attendance: Madame Chair Lisa Robinson, Winton Hunter, Sandy Edge, Elaine Masceri, Pablo Unda, Caroline Beatty and Chief Campos.

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Madame Chair Lisa Robinson @ 6:00pm.

Roll Call: Roll was called by Madame Chair Lisa Robinson. Ava Ross has an excused absence. Kevin Dull absent. Jacquie Myers absent.

Approval of Agenda: Pablo Unda made motion to approve agenda. Seconded by Winton Hunter. Motion carried.

Approval of previous meeting minutes – September 4, 2025: Winton Hunter made a motion to approve. Caroline Beatty seconded. Motion carried.

Citizen Comments: No citizen's comments or questions presented.

Department Status / Staffing Review: Chief Campos provided a synopsis of current matters with the Department.

- All patrol positions are filled
 - Two in pre-academy training
 - Two in field training and have a few weeks left to go solo.
- One dispatch vacancy due to a retirement
 - We have a few in various states of training
- Had a quarterly meeting with DOT today.
 - City admin and departments meet to discuss traffic issues.
 - SC133 / US123 light cycling issues
 - Lowering speed limit on College Ave from Edgewood to the lake
 - Waiting on signs.
 - Still working on green crescent trail and some crosswalk improvements
 - A lot of the areas are state roads and require DOT approval for changes or updates
 - (Lisa Robinson asked about traffic impact studies) Chief Campos advised he could ask the city engineer to come and explain how those studies are done etc.
- Chief Campos gave a demonstration of a new program that records vehicle speeds based on Bluetooth in cars. It will help us monitor speeds and traffic in the city of Clemson. There are some limitations and extraneous data that may impact some of the numbers. It is a new program but will help us gauge some of the traffic issues. This is a paid service and not available for public at this time.
- New guns for the department should be coming in November. Then we will go through the training
- New cars are still at the upfitters

- Chief Campos just returned from the IACP conference and got a lot of information and updates from around the country. Lots of vendors were there for all kinds of new tech. AI was a big topic of discussion and all the AI products coming out for law enforcement.

Crime Review: Chief Campos gave a rundown of the crime statistics for September 2025.

- 1 aggravated assault
- 14 simple assaults
- 5 breaking and entering
 - In ref to the post for attempt to identify we had suspect identified in about 2 hours
- 3 thefts from buildings
- 17 thefts from motor vehicles
- 10 motor vehicles thefts
 - Most were mopeds
- 16 narcotics charges
- 10 DUI
- 78 MIP
- 7 public drunks
- Over 700 traffic stops
- Over 500 citations
- There have been some golf cart charges

(Note: Crime mapping system is still not working at this time. They are still having technical difficulties with the new CAD system)

Requested Presentations: Earlier mention of having City Engineer talk about traffic studies. Caroline Beatty advised that the student body president agreed to speak during the January meeting. CC - we may also try to get the graduate president to speak as well.

Board Member Open Discussion: They have the CUPD director candidates narrowed down to two. Elaine Masceri mentioned the traffic issues at Issaqueena and Berkley. Suggested maybe a turn lane to help mitigate some of the flow. Downtown trick or treat will be Oct. 28.

Adjournment: Elaine Masceri made a motion to adjourn. Motion was seconded by Winton Hunter and carried.
